

PASTOR'S JUNE ARTICLE

"A Father's Defining Moment"

I was 19 and a month away from my wedding. I had worked two months with a traveling roofing crew who did not share my values; I had an allergic reaction to some of the materials we used. Bottom line I didn't like my job or its environment.

I was home in Anoka for the weekend. The thought of driving early morning back to Paynesville to work in the hot sun on a dirty roof, with a rough crew was not appealing. But my parents insisted I be responsible and go. I got as far as Elk River, 6 miles

away, when my car broke down. My dad had not left for work yet so he came to my rescue.

In my emotional state I was hoping the car wouldn't run. But it was a minor repair and in minutes dad had me ready to leave. I remember sitting behind the steering wheel with the car running. My dad was standing next to my open window encouraging me to get going so I wouldn't be late for work. I remember telling him how much I didn't want to go. Then unexpectedly a flood of tears. I was emotionally spent and now this young man was crying uncontrollably. I could sense that my dad didn't know what to do.

So he did something I hadn't experienced since I was a little boy. He put his hand on my head and for a moment he did not say a word. But in that silence and feeling his tender touch I was overwhelmed by his love. And then he said two words which I still remember as an act of loving kindness, "Come home".

I do not remember what I did the rest of that day. I remember my mom's surprise when I walked back into the house. I remember I called work and said I wouldn't be to work that day. But the rest of the day is lost to my memory. But what I remember most from that experience is the love of a father to a son who was having a mini melt-down. It empowered me to return to work the next day and every other day until my wedding and then back to college.

Sometimes the greatest messages (or the worse) that we express to our children are not spoken by words, but by actions. June is Father's Day month. Dads I hope that you feel cherished and honored as dads. I hope that the world's definition of manhood has not polluted the affections and tenderness of a father to a son. For we never know, one simple act may be a defining moment in the development of your child. Let us determine to act in the same fashion as our heavenly father acts with us. Creating in our children a godly legacy that they pass along to their children and future generations.
